### **Communication**

The website contains the outbreak plan loaded into a PDF file so that families can get information regarding the staged implementation of reopening. Additionally Residents or their POA can contact the facility at 973-777-7800 at extension 639 for the administrator or extension 643 for nursing or 648 for the Wellness Director.

In the event of a Covid outbreak a letter is sent out to all family members informing them of the situation.

Currently the facility limits its visitation to 15 minute visitation outdoors, family members should register with the facility prior to visiting. Visitors are required to fill out a screening tool and have their temperature taken upon arrival.

### **Staff In-services**

In the event of a new outbreak of Covid 19 or any other infectious disease alternative staff will be called be called to fill in for those staff members who have been affected.

Staff continue to receive In-services on hygiene and other areas pertaining to infectious disease protocol.

Line lists continue to be sent to the local department of health.

Residents are checked symptomatically daily for any adverse symptoms .

Pets at this time are not allowed in the facility.

In the event that a resident is a smoker they will be advised to go to the third floor patio.

### **Infection Control**

The facility shall designate an individual to deal with all areas related to infection control.

Items will be disinfected and sterilized

### **Covid Testing**

Staff Covid testing continues on a regular basis as per the instructions of the local health department. At this current time effective 10/28/2020 no staff or residents are currently testing positive. Any variation to that will be updated accordingly.
